Don P. Osborn is Director and Professor of Graduate Addictions Counseling at Indiana Wesleyan University. He is licensed in Mental Health, Clinical Social Work, Clinical Addictions and Marriage and Family Therapy. Don serves as the Immediate Past President of NAADAC, and is a Senior Fulbright Scholar with the NAADAC Trainers Academy. Don's PhD is Counselor Education and Supervision at Indiana State University, and member of the Association of Counselor Educators and Supervisors (ACES).



Mita M. Johnson, Ed.D, LPC, LMFT, ACS, LAC, MAC, SAP has worked in the behavioral health profession as a mental health and substance abuse clinician, educator, and clinical supervisor for over 25 years. Mita

is a professor at Metropolitan State University of Denver and Argosy University in Denver. She provides live and on-line trainings throughout Colorado, including trainings for NAADAC. Mita is the Immediate Past President of the Colorado Association of Addiction Professionals (NAADAC state affiliate) and is the current NAADAC Southwest Regional Vice President. Mita was awarded the 2013 Therapist of the Year by the Colorado Association of Marriage and Family Therapists, the 2013 Colorado Excellence in Leadership Award, and the Dr. James R. Beck Counseling Excellence Award. She is a Governor's appointee to the Behavioral Health Transformation Council.

## ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Evidence points to the utility of groups; participating in a group can be transformational. We will discuss the dynamics of group practice, specifically the culture of groups and how differences in personalities and life experiences challenge groups to grow. Ethical group participation and ethical group practices will be discussed. We will look at different types of groups and when they are best used. Together, as a group, we will look at common problems that are faced by groups and brainstorm ways to handle those difficulties that engages everyone. The other group activity will be to come up with experiential activities and ice-breakers that energize groups and/or build cohesion within a group.
