Meet the Speaker



Arlene K. Story, LMHC, LCAC, TEP, CSAT-S, CTT, received her degree in Marriage and Family Therapy from Indiana University in Fort Wayne. She is certified as a Trainer, Educator, Practitioner (TEP) in Sociometry, Psychodrama and Group Psychotherapy by the American Board of Examiners. Additionally, she is certified as a Sex Addiction Therapy Supervisor, (CSAT-S) through the International Institute for Trauma and Addiction Professionals (IITAP). Her certification as a Trauma Therapist (CTT) is through Spirit 2 Spirit Trauma Training Institute. Arlene has worked in the mental health and addiction fields for over 35 years, and during the past 30 years has conducted thousands of training seminars throughout the U.S and in Europe. Arlene was one of the founding members of the Indiana Association for Addiction Professionals (IAAP) and served on the Board of Directors until moving to Florida in 2007 to work at one of the premier trauma and addiction treatment centers in the United States. Additionally, she worked as one of the faculty for the Spirit2Spirit training certification programs for trauma therapy. Recently, Arlene relocated back in Indiana and is continuing her work with training and teaching, and providing clinical supervision for professionals through the Psychodrama Training and Consulting, LLC in Fort Wayne, IN. Her passion is working with and training others to work with those people who are deeply wounded and often rejected or deemed as hopeless by the mainstream therapy community.

About the Sessions

THE WHEN AND HOW . . .

Treating Traumatized, Addicted Clients Practitioner - Focus

This workshop will focus on identifying and understanding differential treatment protocols for simple vs. complex trauma in clients with substance addiction and clients with multiple addictions. Additionally, it will address the importance of understanding the role of brain injury that results from both trauma and addictions and often has a significant impact on overall treatment outcomes when left unaddressed. Participants will be actively involved in this all-day experience and have opportunities to do the following:

- * Identify the difference in treatment for simple trauma vs. complex trauma
- * Identify the difference in treatment protocols for substance addiction vs. multiple addiction
- * Identify effective treatment interventions and when to use them
- * Understand the complexity of developing effective treatment strategies

ENGAGING COMPLEX SEXUALLY ADDICTED CLIENTS IN THE TREATMENT PROCESS

Practitioner - Focus

This workshop will focus on understanding the diverse symptomatology with sexually addicted clients and the complexities involved in developing treatment planning strategies. Through both didactic presentations and small group experiences, participants will have an opportunity to learn important aspects of the assessment and recovery process. The following topics will be addressed:

- * How to gather important clinical data that is often overlooked
- * Questions that arise from what is not said by the client
- * How to develop a treatment plan and access necessary resources
- * How to engage the client's significant other in the treatment process
- * How the therapist can deal with their own feelings, thoughts, and reactions in working with sexually addicted clients
