## Workshop Description: February 12<sup>th</sup>

Based on the popular book, "Essentials of Clinical Supervision," this all day training seminar addresses the top ten topics in supervision and provides practical suggestions for integrating each of the topics into the supervisory process. These top ten topics include: 1) ethical dilemmas and possible pitfalls, 2) Legal parameters, 3) clinical models and how to use them, 4) various formats (e.g. individual, group, team and departmental), 5) methodology (reading, writing, videotaping, conference calling), 6) applicable techniques, 7) how to prepare for supervision and 8-10) the stages of supervision from the beginning to the advanced stage. In addition, how to form and maintain communication with off-site, co-supervisors and an examination of new trends in online supervision will also be presented.

Other information: A special emphasis will be placed on the practical application of the top ten topics. To that end, activities, videos, group discussions and time for questions with immediate feedback have been integrated into the training seminar.
